#### Automatic Screen Capture Tool

Gadwin PrintScreen is an easy to use one-click screen capture tool, that captures the contents of your screen. The captured screen can then be sent to the printer, or saved to disk as a file in 6 different graphics file formats (JPG, GIF, PNG, BMP, TGA and TIF) with optional drop shadow effects. Gadwin PrintScreen supports capturing the entire screen, the active window, the client area or a specified rectangular selection with optional inclusion of the mouse cursor. You can choose to copy the captured image to the clipboard or to auto-save it into a default directory of your choice (with auto-naming option). The hot key defaults to the PrintScreen key, but users may also define other keys to initiate a capture. In addition, Gadwin PrintScreen also includes a feature that allows you to e-mail the captured images automatically.

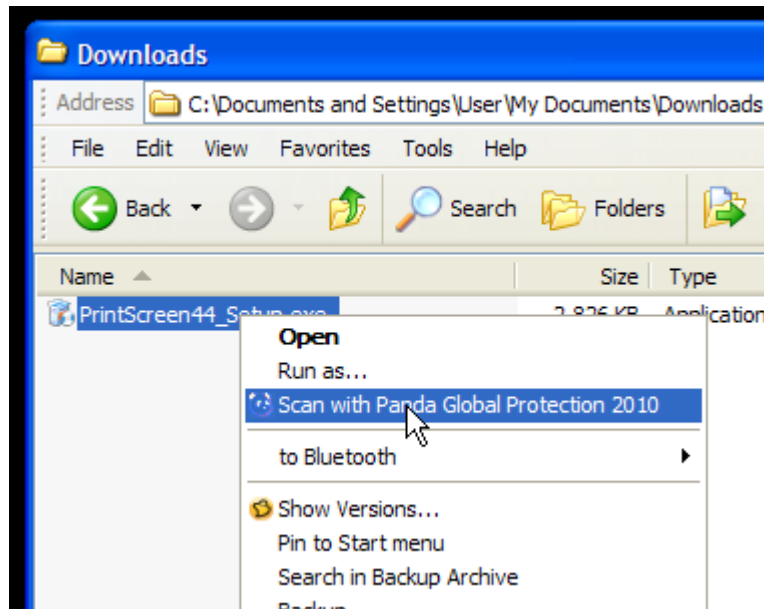

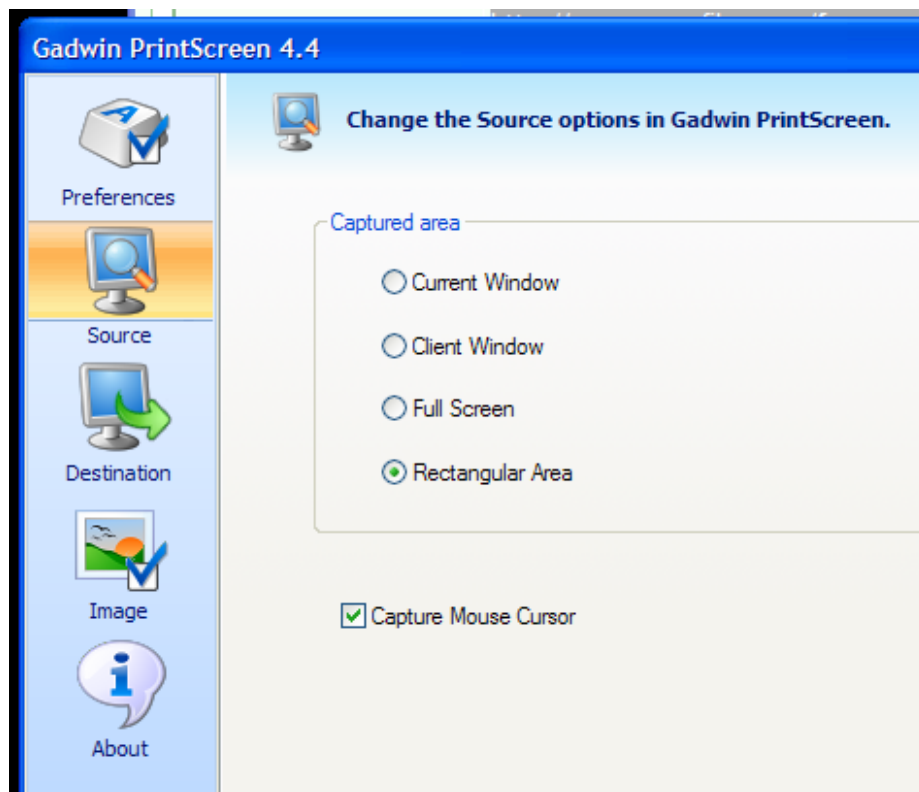

STEP 2: After downloading the installer, scan it for viruses and/or malware



STEP 3: Run the installer. This installs “Gadwin PrintScreen” on your computer. I recommend you choose the “Rectangular Area” method of selecting the a region of the screen to be captured:



STEP 4: Find something on your screen whose image you wish to capture.

STEP 5: Press the hot key (which you probably left as the default, i.e., the “Prt Scrn” key). This brings up a Selection Box cursor and a Zoom window. Drag the mouse across a rectangle to choose the area of the screen to be captured




STEP 6: Press the ENTER key. This finalizes the area selection and opens an Image Preview window:



STEP 7: If you are pleased with your captured image, click on “Continue Output” and save the image as a file on your hard drive. Here is the above, after saving:



STEP 8: To paste the captured image into a message on the Trader's Roundtable, edit a message (either "New Topic" or "Reply"), and click on "Add Attachment"




**Attachment Posting Control Panel**

If you click on Add an Attachment, you will see the box for adding Attachments.  
If you click on Posted Attachments, you will see a list of already attached Files and you are able to edit them.  
If you want to Replace (Upload new Version) an Attachment, you have to click both links. Add the Attachment, click on Add Attachment, rather click on Upload New Version at the Attachment Entry you intend to update.

STEP 9: Click the Browse button and navigate to the place on your hard drive where you saved the image file. Add a Comment if you wish:
