

Import the Vendor Portfolio "Trading Blox Futures"




Answer Yes to build the files




Make note of the Directory these files will be located in. In this case "C:\ua\Files\TBLOX Futures\

Note that the Edit Portfolio button can be used to change the location of the data files at this point, if another location is more suitable.




In Trading Blox Preferences, Data and Order Folders, select this folder for the Futures Data Folder




Verify the folder is correct and press OK to close the Preferences Dialog.


If there is a dialog about an existing dictionary, then this is not a full fresh install. Be sure to



Launch the Futures Dictionary Editor using the menu item. Verify the location and press the "New Dictionary" button to create a default CSI Futures Dictionary that matches the CSI UA Portfolio. This process actually just copies an existing default dictionary from the install folder into your chosen data folder for convenience.



The Futures Dictionary should look like this, with the location and file names matching the setup in CSI UA



Then to add new markets to your available portfolio, add those to the CSI UA portfolio, and use this simple two step process to add to Trading Blox:
